AN ACT

To incorporate the Female medical college of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That William J. Mullen, Frederick A. Fickard, M. D., Henry Gibbons, M. D., Jos. S. Longshore, M. D., Ferdinand Dreer, William J. Birkey, M. D., R. P. Kane, John Longstreth, and their associates, be incorporated under the name, style and title of "The Female medical college of Pennsylvania," for the purpose of instructing females in the science and art of medicine; the said college to have all the powers and be subject to the restrictions contained in the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Franklin medical college," approved the twenty-eighth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.*
