A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of New Castle, in the county of Mercer, and the town of Blairsville, in the county of Indiana; relative to the petition of David M'Cullough; and relative to the real estate of Henry M'Cullough."

Power and duties of assessing street tax in the borough of Blairsville, Indiana county, vested in the burgess and council.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act of the general assembly to which this is a supplement, passed the twenty-fifth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five, as provides for the election of street supervisors in the borough of Blairsville, in the county of Indiana, and prescribes their powers and duties, be and the same is hereby repealed; and the power and duty of assessing the necessary street tax in said borough, shall be transferred and hereafter vested in the burgesses and council thereof, who shall perform all the other duties heretofore performed by the street supervisors aforesaid, under the act to which this is a supplement.

Orphans' court of Indiana county vested with full and complete jurisdiction in case of the petition of David M'Cullough.

SECTION 2. That the orphans' court of Indiana county be and hereby is vested with full and complete jurisdiction in the case of the petition of David M'Cullough, for the maintainance of his wife and her children, charged on real estate in said county, by the will of William Armstrong, deceased, proceedings wherein have been commenced in said court; and the said orphans' court is hereby authorized and required to re-hear, determine and decree in said case, as to it may seem just and equitable, with the same force and effect as if said case had been originally cognizable in said court; and in the event of a decree being made in favor of the petitioner, that the same shall be made for the amount due at the time of the decree.

Real estate of Henry M'Cullough, annexed to the borough of Lawrenceville.

SECTION 3. That the real estate of Henry M'Cullough, situated on the south side of the Pittsburg and Greensburg turnpike, partly within the borough of Lawrenceville, and partly in the township of Peebles, Allegheny county, be and it is hereby annexed to the borough of Lawrenceville, in said county.
