A N A C T

Relating to the Wayne County mutual insurance company.

Required to publish annual report.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Wayne County mutual insurance company be and they are hereby required to publish their report annually, in one weekly newspaper of the county, for three successive weeks; and said report shall contain the number of members, the amount insured, the amount of premium notes, the amount of moneys received, the amount of losses during the year, and the date of such loss, and by whom the amount paid out for losses and expenses, and to whom, the amount of moneys in the treasury, and the amount of claims against the company; said report shall be made and published within four weeks after the annual meeting of the board of directors; in case of neglect or refusal, the said corporation, the president, secretary, treasurer, or either of them, shall forfeit and pay one hundred dollars, to be recovered in any court having competent jurisdiction.

Repeal.

SECTION 2. That the acts of the thirteenth of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, and of twenty-third of April, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine, relating to foreign insurance companies or their agents, be and they are hereby repealed, so far as relates to Wayne county.
