AN ACT

Relative to the survey books of Butler county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the court of general quarter sessions of the peace of the county of Butler is hereby authorized to direct the deputy surveyor of said county to copy into a suitable book, all the original surveys made by former deputy surveyors in said county, on warrants, improvements, or otherwise; and that the said book, when certified to be a true copy of the original, and submitted to and approved by the said court, shall be received in evidence in any judicial proceeding, in the same manner as the original books; and the commissioners of said county shall, out of the funds of the county, pay the said deputy surveyor a reasonable compensation, to be by them fixed, subject to the approval of the court of general quarter sessions of the peace aforesaid.

SECTION 2. That the provision of the seventh section of an act, entitled "An Act authorizing the sale of certain real estate, and relative to the collection of taxes in certain townships in Monroe, Berks and Lancaster counties, and certain school districts in Butler, Franklin, Mifflin, Indiana and Schuylkill counties," approved the tenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, be and they are hereby extended to the townships of Penn. West Hempfield, Manor and Rapho, in the county of Lancaster.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Tioga and Lawrenceville plank road company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That

Location.	road on the bed of the present public road or otherwise, as the company may direct, leading from Tioga to Lawrenceville, in the county of
Subject to provisions of certain act.	Tioga, subject to all the provisions and restrictions of an act regulating turnpike and plank road companies, approved the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, as far as they are not inconsistent with this and the following sections.
Capital stock.	SECTION 2. That the capital stock of said company shall consist of eight hundred shares of twenty-five dollars per share: <i>Provided</i> , That said company may from time to time, at a meeting of the stockholders called for that purpose, increase the capital stock to such an amount as in their opinion may be required to complete the same according to the true intent and meaning of this act:
Commencement and completion of road.	SECTION 3. That if the said company shall not commence the construction of said road within three years from the passage of this act, and complete the same within seven years thereafter, this act shall become null and void, except so far as to wind up the affairs of said company and pay the debts of the same.
Authorized to extend their road.	SECTION 4. That the said company are hereby authorized to extend the said plank road from Tioga aforesaid, up the valley of Crooked creek to Wellsborough, on the bed of the present public road, or otherwise, as the said company may direct, and to increase the capital stock thereof to an amount sufficient for the purposes aforesaid, in a manner prescribed in the second section of this act.
Repeal.	SECTION 5. That the act to authorize the Governor to incorporate the Tioga and Elmira plank road company, approved the eighth day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-eight, and the supplement thereto, approved the fifth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, be and the same is hereby repealed.
