AN ACT

Relative to roads and supervisors in the townships of Pennsbury and Pocopson, Chester county; and George township, Fayette county.

Bridges in Pennsbury and Pocopson townships, Chester county, relative to the erection of.

Election of supervisors in Pennsbury township.

Repeal.

Provision of said act extended to Pocopson township.

Further powers extended to said township.

George township, Fayette county, authorized to elect four supervisors, &c.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* from and after the passage of this act, it shall be lawful for the supervisors of the townships of Pennsbury and Pocopson, in Chester county, to sell or let at public sale the erection of any bridge they may be required to build; and also, the opening of any new road laid out by authority of law in said townships: *Provided*, The supervisors give notice of said sale in the same manner as they are required to give in the selling of the repairs of the roads in said township.

SECTION 2. That it shall be lawful for the taxable inhabitants of the township of Pennsbury, at their next township election for supervisors of the public roads, to elect one supervisor who shall serve two years, and one person annually thereafter to serve for two years; nor shall there be, at any time, more than two supervisors in said township.

SECTION 3. So much of an act approved the eleventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, relating to public roads and highways, as is inconsistent herewith, is hereby repealed, so far as relates to the township of Pennsbury, in Chester county.

SECTION 4. That the provisions of the said act be and they are hereby extended to the township of Pocopson, in said county: *Provided*, That the qualified citizens of said township shall elect annually two supervisors, whose term of service shall be one year.

SECTION 5. That the provisions of an act laying a tax on dogs in the borough of West Chester, and certain townships in the county of Chester, and for other purposes, approved the fourteenth day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-six, be and the same are hereby extended to the township of Pocopson, in said county.

SECTION 6. That the qualified electors of George township, in the county of Fayette, are hereby authorized to elect four supervisors of highways in said township, instead of two, as is now provided for.
