A N A C T

Authorizing the trustee of the estate of Thomas Torrence, a lunatic, to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful for the court of common pleas of Washington county, to authorize and empower the trustee of Thomas Torrence, of Robison township, in said county, a lunatic, to sell and convey a certain tract of land situate in Washington and Allegheny counties, containing about seventy acres, and grant him the power of investing the money in such real estate securities as will be most advantageous to the family of said lunatic, and at the same time secure his support and maintenance: Provided, That the said trustee before he shall make such sale, shall give security, to be approved by the court of common pleas of Washington county, that he will well and faithfully invest the proceeds of the sale of said real estate.*
