

buildings shall be erected, and proceed to erect the same in the manner directed by law, having due regard to the healthfulness of the site, convenience and interest of the citizens of said county, as the amount of subscription to each of said sites: *Provided*, That before proceeding to erect said buildings, they shall take such security as in their judgment shall be ample to insure the payment of the whole amount subscribed to the successful site.

Judgments, relative to.

SECTION 11. That all and every judgment entered by the prothonotary of the court of common pleas of Lawrence county, upon a note or bond, with warrant of attorney to the prothonotary of Beaver and Mercer counties respectively, to enter judgment thereon, where the obligor or obligors in such note or bond, or either of them, shall reside in the county of Lawrence, shall be as good and valid in law as if the prothonotary of the court of common pleas of Lawrence county had been named in the warrant of attorney in such note or bond.

Repeal.

SECTION 12. So much of the act to which this is a supplement, or any other law as is hereby altered or supplied, or is inconsistent herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed.

AN ACT

Declaring Bear creek, in Elk county, Wykoff's run, in Clinton county, and certain streams in Cambria county, public highways; relative to fishing with seines or nets in the waters of Fishing creek, in Clinton county; to the repair of a certain road in M'Kean county, and the construction of a dam across Clarion river.

Bear creek declared a public highway.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Bear creek, in the county of Elk, be and the same is hereby declared to be a public highway, from its junction with the Clarion river, for one mile up said creek.

Wykoff's run.

SECTION 2. That Wykoff's run, in the county of Clinton, be and the same is hereby declared to be a public highway from its junction with the Sinnemahoning, for six miles up said run.

Repeal.

SECTION 3. That so much of the twelfth section of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Alexandria Delaware bridge company," approved May eighth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, prohibiting the fishing with seines or nets in the waters of Fishing creek,

county of Clinton, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as the same relates to the townships of Logan and Greene, in said county.

SECTION 4. That the commissioners of M'Kean county are hereby authorized, if they deem it necessary and proper, to appropriate from the funds of said county, the sum of one thousand dollars, for the repair and improvement of that part of the public highway leading from Tunongwant creek, in Bradford township, in said county, to the Allegheny river in Eldred township, which lies between the east line of Bradford township aforesaid, and the saw mill known as the Beardsly mill, on Foster creek, in said township of Bradford; the money so appropriated to be expended under the direction of said commissioners: *Provided*, That not more than one-third of said sum shall be appropriated and expended in any one year. Commissioners of M'Kean county, for the recertain powers granted to.

SECTION 5. That Grinfell Blake and his associates, be and are hereby authorized to construct a dam across the Clarion river, for milling purposes, at or near Beach bottom, in Elk county: *Provided*, The same shall not be built over three and an half feet above low water mark, and subject to the provisions and penalties as are provided for by an act passed thirtieth of March, eighteen hundred and forty-six, entitled "An Act in relation to the obstruction of the Clarion river, and for other purposes." Grinfell Blake and associates authorized to construct a dam across the Clarion river.

SECTION 6. That the following creeks, viz: from the mouth of Beaver creek to the mouth of Killbuck creek; from the mouth of North Beaver Dam run to Gill's saw mill; from the mouth of Slate Lick run to the Philipsburg road; from the mouth of Beaver Dam creek to the place the township road crosses it; all in the county of Cambria, be and the same are hereby declared to be public highways. Mouth of Beaver creek and Killbuck, &c., declared public highways.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act relating to inspections, passed the fifteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five; in relation to path-masters in Erie county; the appointment of a flour inspector in Luzerne county; and to tavern licenses in Philadelphia city and county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That Flour inspector, the governor is hereby authorized to appoint an inspector of flour and borough of Erie.
