

proceeds of the said sale at the rate of five per centum per annum, for the remainder of the period mentioned in the said act of the eighth of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four; and so much of the said acts of the twenty first of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six, and the sixteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-seven, as provides for the release of the state from the payment of the interest on the said loan, be and the same is hereby repealed: *And provided also*, That nothing contained in this act shall be held, taken or construed to interfere with or affect the title of Reuben Fagely, in and to certain lots of ground in the borough of Sunbury, sold by the sheriff of Northumberland county, as the property of said railroad company, and purchased at said sheriff's sale by the said Reuben Fagely, nor shall any sale under the provisions of this act, or any of the acts herein referred to, be held to divest the title of the said Reuben Fagely, his heirs or assigns, in and to said lots. Proviso.

AN ACT

To authorize the canal commissioners to examine the claim of the Phoenix line of passenger car company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and directed to examine the claim of the Phoenix line of passenger car company, for damages alleged to have been sustained by them in consequence of a collision on the Columbia railroad on the twentieth of December last, and if they shall ascertain that the damages, if any, were occasioned by any misconduct or carelessness on the part of any state officers or agents, report the amount of such damages to the legislature.
