AN ACT

To incorporate the First Congregational Methodist church of the city and county of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the First Congregational Methodist church of the city and county of Philadelphia, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to hold, purchase and enjoy lands and tenements in the city and county of Philadelphia, for purposes of public worship and for burial purposes and uses, and to grant and convey the whole, or any part of the lands and tenements held by them, to any purchaser or purchasers thereof in fee simple, or for any less estate, free of or subject to the said uses and purposes, as may be deemed right and proper: Provided, The lands held by said church in their corporate capacity, shall at no time exceed three acres.*
