A. SUPPLEMENT

To the act of assembly approved March seventeen, Anno -Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, incorporating the Springhouse and Sumneytown turnpike road company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be lawful for the president and managers of the Springhouse and Sumneytown turnpike road company, or their toll-gatherers, to demand and receive at their respective gates on the said road, the following rates of toll on each and every mile of the travel on the road, or in proportion for a less distance, to wit: For every score of cattle, one and a half cents; for every score of swine or sheep, one cent; for every saddle or led horse, one cent; for every drove horse, half a cent; for every horse drawing a stage for the conveyance of passengers for hire, one and a half cents; for every other wheeled vehicle, the breadth of the wheels of which is less than four inches, one cent for every horse drawing the same; for every horse drawing a vehicle, the breadth of the wheels of which is four inches, or over, half a cent; for every horse drawing a sleigh or sled, half a cent; every mule or ox to be rated the same as a horse; and that in all cases where the travel on fractional portions of the road the toll would not amount to a half cent at the respective gates, that it shall be lawful for the toll-gatherers to demand, and receive half a cent.

SECTION 2. That so much of the thirteenth section of the aforesaid Repeal. act of assembly as is hereby altered or supplied, be repealed.
