AN ACT

Relative to public roads in Monroe and Mercer counties; to repeal an act therein mentioned; and relative to the Somerset and Conemaugh, and Somerset and Cumberland turnpike road company; and relative to the fees of aldermen in the cities of Pittsburg and Allegheny.
