A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled “An Act to incorporate the Manufacturers’ and Mechanics’ Bank of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia,” approved twentieth May, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That so much of the first section of the act, entitled “An Act to incorporate the Manufacturers’ and Mechanics’ Bank of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia,” as requires the said bank to be located in the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia, and to be called the Manufacturers’ and Mechanics’ Bank of the Northern Liberties, in the county of Philadelphia, be and the same is hereby repealed; and that the said bank shall hereafter be called and known by the name of the Manufacturers’ and Mechanics’ Bank of the city and county of Philadelphia; and the passage of this act shall not affect any suits commenced for or against the bank prior to its passage, that the same may be prosecuted to judgment, decree and execution, as if this act had not been passed; and the said bank under the name so changed, shall have all the rights and privileges, and be subject to all the duties and liabilities imposed upon the said bank by existing laws: *Provided*, That said bank shall not be located south of High street, in the city of Philadelphia.
