A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act to enable the governor to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from the northern termination of the York and Conewago turnpike road, to the west end of the Harrisburg bridge, passed the twenty-seventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven; and relative to the elections and boundary line of North Shenango township, in Crawford county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the stockholders in the York Haven and Harrisburg Bridge turnpike road company shall be entitled to all the privileges and immunities, and be subject to all the restrictions contained in the act to which this is a supplement, to be applied to such consecutive portions of said turnpike, at each end thereof, as said company may be enabled to maintain in good repair: *Provided nevertheless,* That the tolls exacted shall be proportionate to those allowed by law for the entire road: *And provided also,* That the officers last elected by said company shall hold their respective offices, and exercise the duties thereof, for the term of two years from the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. That hereafter the qualified electors of North Shenango township, Crawford county, shall hold their general and township elections at the house of James G. Elliott, in said township.

SECTION 3. That hereafter all that part of Pine township, Crawford county, laying west of a straight line, commencing at the south-east corner of a tract of land in Conneaut township, formerly owned by Enoch D. Thomas, and in which the said Thomas now resides; thence running south until it intersects the line of North Shenango township, shall be attached to, and be a part of North Shenango township, in Crawford county, for all township and county purposes.
