AN ACT

To repeal the twenty-seventh section of an act authorizing the laying out of certain state roads, passed the fifth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three; and relative to the Equitable life insurance company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Roads in Dublin township, Huntingdon county, the twenty-seventh section of an act passed the fifth of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, authorizing the laying out of certain state roads, be and the same is hereby repealed as act concerning, repealed. far as relates to Dublin township, in Huntingdon county.

SECTION 2. 'That from and after the passage and acceptance of this act, the Equitable life insurance company shall be known in law by the corporate name of "The Equitable-mutual life insurance company;" Equitable life insurance company, name changed. that it shall be lawful for said company to adopt the mutual principle of insurance upon such terms, and subject to such regulations as shall be agreed upon by the trustees thereof: *Provided,* 'That all persons hereafter insured with said company, be allowed one vote at all elections for trustees during any year for which they shall have duly paid their premiums in advance: *And provided further,* 'That no person so insured shall be liable for any losses or expenses of said company beyond the amount of such premiums as shall have been agreed to be paid.
