To incorporate the Boalsburg and Bellefonte turnpike road company.

- Commissioners.** SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That George Boal, John Hasson, George Shenoberger, George Jack, B. J. Berry, Andrew Gregg, George W. Johnston, John Mitchell, Christian Dale and John Thompson, of Boalsburg and Spring creek, and Hamilton Humes, Henry Brokerhoff, William A. Thomas, James Burnside, H. N. M'Alister, Henry P. Treziyulney, Felix Mullen, J. H. Morrison and J. T. Hale, of Bellefonte, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open books, receive subscriptions and organize a company, by the style and title of "The Boalsburg and Bellefonte turnpike road company," with power to construct a turnpike road commencing at Boalsburg, and thence by the end of the mountain on the most eligible ground to Bellefonte, subject to all the provisions and restrictions of an act regulating turnpike and plank road companies, approved the twenty-sixth day of January, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and the supplement thereto.
- Style.**
- Subject to provisions of certain act.**
- Capital stock.** SECTION 2. The capital stock of said company shall consist of six hundred shares of twenty-five dollars per share.
- Commencement and completion of road.** SECTION 3. That if said company shall not commence the construction of said road within three years, and complete the same within six years from the passage of this act, then it shall be null and void, except so far as the same may be necessary to wind up the affairs and pay the debts of the company.
