AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract between Sarah J. Mason and John C. Mason.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into in the city of Philadelphia on the twenty-ninth day of January, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, before the reverend William Sudders, between Sarah J. Lore and John C. Mason, alias Bradley, alias Lanning, be and the same is hereby declared null and void, and the parties discharged from all liabilities and obligations growing out of the same, as fully and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.*

AN ACT

To provide for the erection of a house for the employment and support of the poor in the county of Huntingdon; and to regulate the settlement of paupers in the county of Chester; to authorize the Ohio and Pennsylvania railroad company to borrow money; relative to the collection of taxes in the city of Pittsburg; and to the estate of John Hoff, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That Thomas Fisher, Kenzie L. Green, Benjamin Leas, James Gillam, John M'Culloch, John Porter, Isaac Taylor, A. P. Wilson, John Watson, Caleb Greenland, S. Miles Green, be and are hereby appointed commissioners, whose duty it shall be, or a majority of them, on or before the first day of January, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, to determine upon and purchase such real estate as they shall*
