That the president and managers of the Coal Hill and Upper St. Clair turnpike road company, incorporated June seventh, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to extend their road to the Washington county line, and if they shall deem it expedient, to change the same, or any part thereof, into a plank road.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Ocean Mail steam packet company; relative to the Philadelphia loan company; and to authorize Rebecca Large to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That Ambrose W. Thompson, Benjamin W. Tingley, William M. Godwin, Stephen R. Crawford, William Craig; William G. Alexander, Davis B. Stacy, James M'Clintock and John L. Linton, and such other persons as may become associated with them, be and they are hereby created and made a body politic and corporate, by the name, style and title of "The Ocean Mail steam packet company;" and the said corporators hereby have full power to fill all the subscriptions to the capital stock, and organize the said company at such time as may to them be proper so to do; and that they further have all the powers and privileges granted to the Philadelphia and Atlantic steam navigation company; and also, that they be and are hereby authorized to increase their capital stock to such an amount as may be necessary, not exceeding three millions dollars, to establish lines of mail steamship packets, for the conveyance of the United States mails from any port in Pennsylvania, and from any port in California, Europe or South America: *Provided*, That nothing in the act referred to or in this act shall be construed to give the company the privilege of trading to any port on the Atlantic coast in the United States, north of Charleston, South Carolina.

SECTION 2. That it shall not be lawful for the directors of the Philadelphia loan company to make any distribution, dividend or payment of the capital stock or funds of said company, until all the certificates of deposit issued by said company or its officers shall be fully settled and satisfied, received and cancelled, by the said directors; and any payment, dividend or distribution of the assets of said company in violation of this law, shall render the directors or other officers making the same, and the stockholders receiving the same, liable for the amount thereof, jointly and severally, to the holder or holders of any such certificate of deposit issued as aforesaid by such company or its officers: *Provided*, That such certificates of deposit be presented by the holders thereof within six months from the passage of this act.

SECTION 3. That Rebecca Large, wife of John Baldwin Large, of the city of Philadelphia, be and she is hereby authorized to convey, assure and dispose of and confirm the title to all or any part of the real estate devised in trust for her by Mrs. Dorothy Large, by her last will and testament, dated the third day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, duly proved and registered in the office of the register of wills for the city and county of Philadelphia; and also of all or any part of the real estate conveyed to the said Rebecca Large by Sarah Large Mifflin, by deed, dated June twentieth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, recorded in the proper office at Philadelphia, in deed book S H F, No. three, page five hundred and sixty-eight, as fully and effectually in all respects as though the said Rebecca Large were a feme sole, and under no disabilities of coverture.

AN ACT

Relative to the pay of the county commissioners of Westmoreland county; and to incorporate the Philadelphia association and reading room.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the county commissioners of Westmoreland county shall in addition to the daily pay now allowed them by law, be entitled to the sum of one dollar for every day that they may be necessarily engaged in transacting the business of the county at any other place than at the county seat.
