

SECTION 2. That it shall not be lawful for the directors of the Philadelphia loan company to make any distribution, dividend or payment of the capital stock or funds of said company, until all the certificates of deposit issued by said company or its officers shall be fully settled and satisfied, received and cancelled, by the said directors; and any payment, dividend or distribution of the assets of said company in violation of this law, shall render the directors or other officers making the same, and the stockholders receiving the same, liable for the amount thereof, jointly and severally, to the holder or holders of any such certificate of deposit issued as aforesaid by such company or its officers: *Provided*, That such certificates of deposit be presented by the holders thereof within six months from the passage of this act.

SECTION 3. That Rebecca Large, wife of John Baldwin Large, of the city of Philadelphia, be and she is hereby authorized to convey, assure and dispose of and confirm the title to all or any part of the real estate devised in trust for her by Mrs. Dorothy Large, by her last will and testament, dated the third day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and twenty-seven, duly proved and registered in the office of the register of wills for the city and county of Philadelphia; and also of all or any part of the real estate conveyed to the said Rebecca Large by Sarah Large Mifflin, by deed, dated June twentieth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, recorded in the proper office at Philadelphia, in deed book S H F, No. three, page five hundred and sixty-eight, as fully and effectually in all respects as though the said Rebecca Large were a feme sole, and under no disabilities of coverture.

AN ACT

Relative to the pay of the county commissioners of Westmoreland county; and to incorporate the Philadelphia association and reading room.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the county commissioners of Westmoreland county shall in addition to the daily pay now allowed them by law, be entitled to the sum of one dollar for every day that they may be necessarily engaged in transacting the business of the county at any other place than at the county seat.

SECTION 2. That Hymen Gratz, Charles F. Lex, Samuel B. Thomas, John Biddle, M. D., Joseph Swift, and their associates, be and they are hereby created a body corporate and politic, with the name, style and title of "The Philadelphia association and reading room," with authority to elect officers, to establish by laws for their government, and to hold real estate, the yearly value of which shall not exceed three thousand dollars: *Provided*, That nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to authorize said "Philadelphia association and reading room," to do any other act or acts in their corporate capacity than are herein expressed.

AN ACT

Annexing certain real estate of George C. Thompson, of Armstrong township, Indiana county, to Centre township, in said county; and to change the time of the annual elections of the Williamsport bridge company.

Certain township, Indiana county, enlarged.

Time of election of Monongahela and Williamsport bridge company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the farm of George C. Thompson, situate partly in Armstrong and partly in Centre township, in the county of Indiana, shall be and the same is hereby annexed to the township of Centre, in said county.

SECTION 2. That from and after June next, the annual election of the company incorporated to erect a bridge over the Monongahela, at Williamsport, shall be held on the second Tuesday of March in each and every year.
