

Election of officers.

SECTION 6. That whenever one hundred shares shall be subscribed of twenty-five dollars each, any three stockholders may call a meeting by putting up written or printed notices in at least four of the most public places along said contemplated road, for the election of one person as president, and four persons as directors, who shall form an executive board; and one person as treasurer and one person as superintendent, who shall hold their office for the term of one year, and until their successors are elected.

Commencement and completion of road.

SECTION 7. That if the said company shall not commence the construction of the said road within three years after the granting of this charter, and complete the same within ten years thereafter, this act shall be null and void, except so far as the same may be necessary to wind up the affairs and pay the debts of said company.

AN ACT

Extending Pickering street, in the borough of Brookville, Jefferson county, Pennsylvania; and incorporating the Graphic association of Philadelphia.

Pickering street, in Brookville, extended.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Pickering street, in the borough of Brookville, Jefferson county, Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby extended from the south-east corner of the bridge over Red Bank creek, in said borough; south along the west side of the out lots until the same shall strike the aforesaid creek; that part so extended to be thirty-five feet in width.

Commissioners.

SECTION 2. That E. Heath, J. B. Evans and Philip Taylor, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to survey and lay out the aforesaid street.

Incorporate.

SECTION 3. That the members of the association called the Graphic association of Philadelphia, and all such persons as now are or may be hereafter admitted members of said association, shall be and they are hereby declared a body politic and corporate by the name and style of "The Graphic association of Philadelphia," to have perpetual succession, and be capable to take, hold and enjoy lands, tenements and hereditaments; to use a common seal, and to break, alter or renew the same at pleasure: *Provided*, That the clear yearly value of the real estate by them held, shall not exceed three thousand dollars.

SECTION 4. That the officers of the said corporation shall consist of a president, treasurer and secretary, to be chosen annually by ballot on the second Thursday in November; if an election shall not be held at the time appointed, the corporation shall not for that cause be dissolved, but an election shall be held as soon afterwards as may be, and until such election the officers in place shall continue to act; the present officers, viz: president Peter F. Rothermel, treasurer Samuel B. Waugh, secretary Abraham Woodside, shall continue to hold and exercise their respective offices.

Elect officers annually.

If election not held, corporation not dissolved.

Present officers continued.

SECTION 5. That the powers and duties of the officers herein mentioned, and of all others who may be hereafter appointed, the time of meeting of the said corporation, the admission of new members and the other concerns of said corporation, shall be regulated by the by-laws and ordinances of said corporation.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Ebensburg and Susquehanna plank road company; and relative to the claim of Robert Lytle; and to an election district in Huntingdon county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Johnston Moore, Edward Shoemaker, John Williams, Ezekiel Hughes, Patrick M'Coy, James Murray, Charles Litzinger, Robert L. Johnston, James Myers, Francis Bearer, David R. Kinports, Peter Garman, junior, John P. Urban, Jacob Luther and Isaac Gifford be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open books, receive subscriptions and organize a company, by the name, style and title of "The Ebensburg and Susquehanna plank road company," with power to construct a plank road from Ebensburg, in Cambria county, to some point on the Susquehanna river, at or near the Cherry Tree, in said county, by the nearest and best route or routes as the stockholders or directors may determine upon, subject to all the provisions and restrictions of an act regulating turnpike and plank road companies, passed the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and the supplement thereto, so far as they are not inconsistent with this and the following sections.
