## A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the York gas company; to collectors of corporation and poor taxes in Philadelphia county; and to side-walks in Mount Airy, Philadelphia county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the York gas company be and is, hereby authorized to increase the capital stock of the said company to an amount not exceeding four hundred additional shares. York gas company authorized to increase capital stock.

SECTION 2. That the persons who shall be elected by the qualified voters of the several wards in the incorporated districts in the county of Philadelphia, to collect state and county taxes as now provided for by law, shall have power and authority to collect corporation and poor taxes; and in addition to the security now required to be given in the case of the collection of state and county taxes, every collector shall give security for the corporation tax, to be approved by the commissioners of the proper district, and for the poor tax to be approved by the guardians of the poor. Corporation and poor taxes in the incorporated districts in the county of Philadelphia, relative to the collection of.

SECTION 3. That the commissioners authorized to grade, pave and curb the side-walks on the Germantown and Perkiomen turnpike road, in the Upper ward of Germantown, between Carpenter and Gorgas streets, and Allen's lane at Mount Airy, under the second section of an act passed the sixth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, entitled "An Act relative to the Upper ward Germantown, and to the boundary line of the district of Kensington, in the county of Philadelphia, and declaring the Oswego creek, in the county of Potter, a public highway," shall not remove any wall already in use either as a curb wall or as a dividing line for the side-walk: *Provided,* That the side-walk is ten feet wide, nor shall they remove any ornamental or shade trees along said side-walk. Germantown and Perkiomen turnpike road company not to remove any wall already in use, &c.
