A. SUPPLEMENT

To the act relative to the Tioga navigation company; authorizing the managers of the Columbia and Marietta turnpike road company to borrow money; and relative to tavern licenses in the city of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That*

Time for dissenting to the act for the relief of the Tioga navigation company, extended.

the time for dissenting to the act for the relief of the creditors of the Tioga navigation company, passed the sixth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, as specified by the third section of said act, be and is hereby extended to the first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and fifty, and the time for publishing said act directed in the eighth section thereof, is hereby extended to the fifteenth of June, one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

Columbia and Marietta turnpike road company authorized to borrow money.

SECTION 2. That the president and managers of the Columbia and Marietta turnpike road company are hereby authorized to borrow any sum of money, not exceeding two thousand dollars, for the purpose of completing said road.

Relative to the granting of tavern licenses in the city and county of Philadelphia.

SECTION 3. That the second section of the act passed April sixteenth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, entitled "An Act to change the mode of granting tavern licenses in the city and county of Philadelphia," shall not be so construed as to prevent applicants for license from appearing before any alderman of the city or county of Philadelphia, to qualify their securities.
