To annul the marriage contract between Andrew Nicholson and Celia Ann Nicholson, his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That the marriage contract entered into between Andrew Nicholson, of Indiana county, formerly of Westmoreland, and Celia Ann Nicholson, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.
