AN ACT

Relating to elections in the townships of North Towanda and Litchfield, Bradford county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the township of North Towanda, in the county of Bradford, is hereby erected into a separate election district, and the qualified electors of said township shall hold their general and township elections at the house of Stephen A. Mills, in said township.

SECTION 2. That the qualified electors of the township of Litchfield, in the county of Bradford, shall hereafter hold their general and township elections at the house of Cyrus Bloodgood, in said township, and the polls at said elections, in said township, shall close at six o'clock in the afternoon.
