A SUPPLEMENT

To an act to incorporate the Associated Fireman's Insurance Company of the city of Pittsburgh, approved the twenty-sixth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act incorporating the Associated Fireman's insurance company of the city of Pittsburgh, as requires seven of the directors of said company to be delegates duly elected to the Firemen's association of Pittsburgh, be and the same is hereby repealed, and hereafter not more than three of said directors shall be required to be delegates to said Firemen's association.

AN ACT

Regulating the Tolls of the Wellsboro' and Tioga Plank Road Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act it shall and may be lawful for the Wellsboro' and Tioga Plank Road company to collect and receive of and from all and every person or persons using said road, the tolls and rate hereinafter mentioned, in the place and stead of those mentioned in the thirteenth section of the act of Assembly entitled, an act "Regulating Turnpike and Plank Road companies," approved the twenty-sixth day of January, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, subject to all the provisions and restrictions of said act to which this is a supplement, not inconsistent with this act: That is to say, for every mile in length of said road the following sums of money, and so in proportion for any lesser distance, or for any greater or lesser number of sheep, hogs or cattle, to wit: For every score Tolls.
