A SUPPLEMENT

To an act to authorize the Governor to incorporate the Delaware County Turnpike Road Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Delaware County Turnpike Road Company in reducing the grades of their road and otherwise improving the same, shall be authorized to vary the route or bed thereof, for the purpose of diminishing the expense that would otherwise be incurred in making the proposed grades and improvements: *Provided,* That the said variation or change of route shall be made with the written consent of the owners, or legal representatives of the owners of the land through which the same shall pass, and that the new route shall not at any point be at a greater distance from the present bed of the road than three hundred feet. Authority to vary the route of road.
Proviso.

SECTION 2. That in case of any change having been made in the route of said road, as authorized by the preceding section, it shall be the duty of said company to file a plot or draft thereof in the office of the court of quarter sessions of the proper county, and when the grading and improvement of the part or parts of the road so changed shall have been completed, the bed of the present road between the points of variation shall be vacated. Draft to be filed.

SECTION 3. That the said company shall be authorized to increase the amount of their loans one thousand dollars for every mile of their road west of the intersection of the Darby and Haverford road, which shall be reduced to a grade not exceeding two and a half degrees: *Provided,* No bond shall be issued for a less denomination than one hundred dollars.
