SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Eve Harper, of Washington county, a widow of a soldier of the Revolutionary war, or to her order, an annuity of forty dollars during her natural life, to be paid half yearly, commencing on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.

For the relief of certain Widows of Old Soldiers.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Margaret Muse, of Mercer county; Eunice Boney, of Armstrong county; Jane Harbeson, of Butler county, and Abigail Gibson, of Armstrong county, widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars, a gratuity of forty dollars to each, and an annuity of forty dollars to each annually thereafter during the term of their natural lives, payable half yearly, commencing on the first day of July next, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four.
