HB 1278

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," broadening the commission's authority to sell or exchange lands to the best interests of wildlife management.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The second paragraph of section 904, act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), known as "The Game Law," is amended to read:

Section 904. Exchange or Sale.—* * *

Such lands may also be sold to the Department of Forests and Waters of this Commonwealth, or to the United States of America for National Forests or National Wildlife Refuges, or may be exchanged with such agencies for State Forests [or], National Forests or National Wildlife Refuges when the best interests of the wildlife of the Commonwealth can thus be attained.

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," restricting the game species which may be taken on regulated shooting grounds under three-day nonresident licenses.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The next to last paragraph of section 411, act of June 3, 1937 (P. L. 1225), known as "The Game Law," amended August 8, 1963 (P. L. 615), is amended to read:

Section 411. Shooting Restrictions on Regulated Grounds.—* * *

All species of game other than those specified, found on the premises
