SB 815

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P. L. 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing that schools shall be closed on Memorial Day.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502, act of March 10, 1949 (P. L. 30), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," is amended to read:

Section 1502. Days Schools not to be Kept Open.—No school shall be kept open on any Saturday for the purpose of ordinary instruction, except when Monday is fixed by the board of school directors as the weekly holiday, or on Sunday, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, or Christmas nor shall any school be kept open in any district during the time of holding the teachers' institute for such district. Whenever Memorial day shall be on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday.

SB 524

Directing the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission to assist in the construction of a replica of Fort Franklin, Franklin, Pennsylvania; and making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission for such assistance in cooperation with the Venango County Museum Corporation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission in cooperation with the Venango County Museum Corporation is empowered and directed to assist in the construction and erection of a replica of historic Fort Franklin in Franklin, Pennsylvania, as a permanent historic site and museum devoted to the history of the French
