## A JOINT RESOLUTION

HB 52

Proposing an amendment to article fourteen, section one of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to permit county treasurers to succeed themselves.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby resolves as follows:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the provisions of the eighteenth article thereof:

That section one, article fourteen of the Constitution of the Common-wealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read:

Section 1. <u>County Officers.—County</u> officers shall consist of sheriffs, coroners, prothonotaries, register of wills, recorder of deeds, commissioners, treasurers, surveyors, auditors or controllers, clerks of the courts, district attorneys and such others as may from time to time be established by law. [and no treasurer shall be eligible for the term next succeeding the one for which he may be elected.]
