Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for the liability of county officers and employes for their acts or omissions.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 431, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L. 323, No.130), known as "The County Code," added July 18, 1974 (No.172), is amended to read:

Section 431. Insurance to Protect Against Robbery, Burglary and Larceny; Liability Insurance.—* * *

(b) The county commissioners may provide insurance on every county officer and employe for liability arising from errors, and omissions in the performance of their duties in the course of their employment. ***Their liability for surcharge in accordance with law shall not be affected hereby.***

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
