SUPPLEMENTAL ASSISTANCE PLAN NO. 1 of 1975

- Section 1. (a) Pursuant to the provisions of section 432(2.1), act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the "Public Welfare Code," and the act of April 7, 1955 (P.L.23, No.8), known as the "Reorganization Act of 1955," beginning January 1, 1976, the amount of State supplemental assistance furnished to eligible persons shall be increased so as to be in the amount set forth in section 2 of this Plan for Supplemental Assistance.
- (b) The payments established pursuant to section 2 shall be in addition to payments made by the Federal Government pursuant to the Supplemental Security Income for the Aged, Blind and Disabled Program established by Title XVI of the Social Security Act and shall not be reduced as the result of increased levels of payment established by the Federal Government effected after April 30, 1974.
