

CHAPTER MDCCCVIII.

---

AN ACT TO ERECT THE TOWNSHIP OF HOPEWELL, IN THE COUNTY OF BEDFORD, INTO A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the township of Hopewell, in the county of Bedford, is hereby erected into a separate election district, to be called the tenth election district in the county aforesaid; and the freemen of the said district shall hold their annual elections at the house now occupied by Mordecai Williams, in the township aforesaid.

CHAPTER MDCCXC.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE WILLIAM BEATTY TO ERECT A DAM, FROM SHEEP ISLAND TO THE WEST SIDE OF THE RIVER JUNIATA, IN THE COUNTY OF CUMBERLAND.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That William Beatty, his heirs and assigns, be, and they are hereby, authorized and empowered to erect a dam, from Sheep Island to the west bank of the river Juniata, in the county of Cumberland, and to keep the same in good repair forever, and also to lead off thereby, on his own land, so much of the water of the said river, as may be found necessary for the supply of his water works. Provided always, That the said William Beatty, his heirs or assigns, in erecting
