CHAPTER MDCCCXXXVI.

---

AN ACT TO ERECT THE TOWNSHIP OF MAHANNOY, IN THE COUNTY OF NORTHUMBERLAND, INTO A SEPARATE ELECTION DISTRICT.

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the township of Mahanoy, in the county of Northumberland, is hereby erected into a separate election district, by the name of the tenth district, in the county of Northumberland; and that the freemen residing within the said district are hereby authorized to hold their annual elections at the house now occupied by William Dobson, in said district.
