

they are hereby, authorized to settle and adjust all accounts which may be exhibited by any person or persons legally employed in carrying this act into effect.

[Section VI.] (Section VI, P. L.) And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That all prizes not demanded within twelve months, after publication as aforesaid, shall be considered as relinquished for the benefit of the undertaking.

[Section VII.] (Section VII, P. L.) And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That the said first named commissioners be, and they are hereby, authorized to apply all moneys received as aforesaid, which are not drawn as prizes as aforesaid, or applied to the payment of the expenses aforesaid, to the paving of the streets in the borough of Lancaster aforesaid.

CHAPTER MCMXXVIII.

AN ACT TO EXTEND THE PERIOD HERETOFORE ALLOWED FOR APPLICATIONS FOR DONATION LANDS.

Whereas many persons justly entitled to receive donation lands may have been prevented, by absence and various other sufficient causes, from making application for the same within the period heretofore limited by law:

[Section I.] (Section I, P. L.) Be it therefore enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the period heretofore allowed for making applications for donation lands, shall be extended for one year from and after the passing this act, anything in the act entitled, "An act relative to donation lands,"¹ passed on the seventeenth day of April, in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, to the contrary notwithstanding.
