CHAPTER CVI.

An ACT for annexing Part of Luzerne county to the county of Lycoming.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That all that part of Luzerne county shall be, and hereby is annexed to Lycoming county, which lies west of the following lines, to wit: Beginning at the east side of the east branch of Susquehannah, on the line between Pennsylvania and New-York, at such place that from thence a due south line will strike the north-eastern corner of Clavarack township; thence by the line of the same township about a south-west course, crossing the said east
