CHAPTER CVII.

An ACT declaring Part of Big Fishing-Creek and Cattewiffi Creek, in the county of Northumberland, public Highways.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this act, Big Fishing creek, in the county of Northumberland, from the mouth of Little Fishing creek up to Jonathan Colly's mill, and Cattewiffi creek, in the county aforesaid, up to Cherington's mill, be and the same are hereby declared public highways, for the passage of rafts, boats or other vessels; and it shall and may be lawful for the inhabitants and others

others desirous of using the navigation of said creeks, to remove all natural and artificial obstructions which may be in the same; excepting dams for mills or other water works, and also to erect such slopes at the mill-dams now built in the aforesaid creeks, as may be necessary for the passage of rafts, boats or other vessels: *Provided*, Such slopes be so constructed as not to injure the works of said dams: *And* Proviso in favor of persons owning lands on said creeks. *also*, That any person or persons owning, or possessing lands on said creeks, shall have liberty to erect any dam or dams across the same, agreeably and subject to all the restrictions and provisions of an act of the General Assembly of this commonwealth, passed the twenty-third day of March one thousand eight hundred and three, entitled "An act to authorize any person or persons, owning lands adjoining navigable streams of water declared public highways, to erect dams upon such streams, for mills and other water-works,"
