CHAPTER LXXXV.

An ACT to afford Relief to the Academy at Easton, in Northampton County.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Governor be and he

is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for the sum of two thousand dollars, in favour of the trustees of the Easton Union Academy, for the purpose of enabling them to complete the building for the use of the said institution; to be paid out of the funds appropriated for the support of government.
