

CHAPTER XCI.

An ACT making an Appropriation for the building of a Bridge in Somerset County.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That there is appropriated a sum of four hundred dollars out of the arrearages of State taxes due from the county of Bedford, for the purpose of erecting a bridge over Youghioigeny river, in Somerset county on the road leading from Cumberland, on the Potomack, to Connellsville; which sum shall be paid by the treasurer of Bedford county, on orders to be drawn on him by the commissioners of Somerset county, countersigned by the commissioners of Bedford county, and when paid, the treasurer shall have credit for the same sum in the settlement of his accounts.
