

CHAPTER CXLV.

An ACT granting a sum of Money to the Meadville Seminary, in the County of Crawford.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sum of one thousand dollars, be, and the same hereby is granted out of any money not heretofore appropriated, which may be in the treasury of this commonwealth, to the trustees of the Meadville Seminary of Learning, to be paid on a warrant drawn by the Governor for that purpose, to be appropriated in such judicious manner as they shall think most advantageous to promote the prosperity of the said Seminary.
