AN ACT

To fix the time for filing petitions for nomination with the county commissioners.

Primary elections.
Time for filing
petitions with
commissioners.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That petitions for nomination, required to be filed with the county commissioners, shall be filed at least five weeks before the primary election.

Repeal.

Section 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

AN ACT

To amend section two hundred and twelve of an act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred and forty), entitled "An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating thereto," increasing the compensation of township commissioners of first class townships.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section two hundred and twelve of an act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred and forty), entitled "An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating thereto," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Salary of com-
missioners.

Section 212. Each township commissioner shall receive a salary of [sixty] *one hundred* dollars per year, payable quarterly, as full compensation for the duties imposed by the provisions of this act. A proportionate amount shall be deducted from the salary of any township commissioner for each regular meeting of the board of township commissioners which he fails to attend.
