## AN ACT

To amend section one hundred and ninety-seven of an act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred and forty), entitled "An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating thereto," as amended.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section one hundred and ninety-seven of an act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred and forty), entitled "An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating thereto," which was amended by section two of an act, approved the twenty-ninth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three (Pamphlet Laws, nine hundred and sixteen), entitled "An act to amend section one hundred and ninety-six as amended, section one hundred and ninety-seven as amended, section one hundred and ninety-eight, section four hundred and twenty-seven, section four hundred and thirty-four as amended, and section one thousand and forty of the act, approved the fourteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen (Pamphlet Laws, eight hundred forty), entitled 'An act concerning townships; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating thereto,' is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Officers of county  
association.

Section 197. The officers of the association shall consist of a president, two vice presidents, a secretary, and a treasurer; all of whom, except the secre-

tary, shall be members of the association, and shall hold office for one year or until their successors are chosen. If desirable, the secretary may be a person not a regular member of the association, and may be paid for his service such compensation, not exceeding ten dollars per annum, as the other officers may determine. Every township supervisor, commissioner, and auditor attending such convention may vote in the election of officers. The mayor of any city, the burgess of any borough, or their duly appointed representative, the county commissioners, and the judges of the court in the county, the township commissioner of the State Highway Department, the assistant engineers of the division of township highways, and the superintendent of State highways in charge of such county, shall be eligible to membership, [and to hold office] but shall not be entitled to vote, *nor to hold office*.

### AN ACT

To further amend section two of an act, entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations," approved the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (Pamphlet Laws, seventy-three), as amended; by providing for the incorporation of associations of taxpayers for the encouragement and promotion of good government in any county, city, borough, or township.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section two of the act, approved the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (Pamphlet Laws, seventy-three), entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations," which was amended by an act, approved the ninth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws, twenty-one), entitled "An act to amend the first portion of section two of the act, approved the twenty-ninth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four (Pamphlet Laws, seventy-three), entitled 'An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of certain corporations,' as amended, providing for the incorporation of first class corporations for the purpose of fostering the laying out and adopting and improvement of highway routes and transcontinental highways, and limiting the amount of real estate to be held by first class corporations," is hereby further amended to read as follows:
