AN ACT

To further amend Article XIV of the act, approved the twenty-fourth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1206), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," by authorizing the appointment of special school police and defining their powers and duties.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Article XIV of the act, approved the twenty-fourth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1206), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," as reenacted and amended by the act, approved the twenty-seventh day of May, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 1955), is hereby further amended by adding, immediately following section 1415 thereof, a new section to read as follows:

*Section 1416. Special School Police.—The board of township commissioners, by resolution, may appoint special school police who shall have the duty of controlling and directing traffic at or near schools, and who shall be in uniform and shall display a badge or other sign of authority, and who shall be vested with all of the powers of local police officers. Such police shall serve at the pleasure of the board of township commissioners and shall not come within the civil service provisions of this act.*

Article XIV, act of June 24, 1931, P. L. 1206, as reenacted and amended by act of May 27, 1949, P. L. 1955, further amended by adding, immediately following section 1415, a new section 1416.
