AN ACT

To amend the act, approved the twenty-eighth day of September, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1565), entitled "An act to further amend the act, approved the twenty-first day of January, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 3), entitled 'An act relating to officers and employes of the General Assembly; fixing the number, qualifications, compensation, mileage and duties of the officers and employes of the Senate and the House of Representatives; providing for their election or appointment, term of office, or of service, removal, and manner of filling vacancies; and making appropriations to the Senate, House of Representatives and Legislative Reference Bureau,' by providing for compensation on a daily basis for certain employes of the General Assembly when a regular biennial session of the General Assembly remains in session beyond the fifteenth day of June; making appropriations," by providing for compensation on a daily basis for certain employes of the General Assembly when the Legislature is in regular session beyond the fifteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred fifty-three, and each regular session thereafter.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 4 of the act, approved the twenty-eighth day of September, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one (Pamphlet Laws 1565), entitled "An act to further amend the act, approved the twenty-first day of January, one thousand nine hundred forty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 3), entitled 'An act relating to officers and employes of the General Assembly; fixing the number, qualifications, compensation, mileage and duties of the officers and employes of the Senate and of the House of Representatives; providing for their election or appointment, term of office, or of service, removal, and manner of filling vacancies; and making appropriations to the Senate, House of Representatives and Legislative Reference Bureau,' by providing for compensation on a daily basis for certain employes of the General Assembly when a regular biennial session of the General Assembly remains in session beyond the fifteenth day of June; making appropriations," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. The provisions of this act shall become effective immediately upon final enactment; and the daily compensation provided for in this act shall be payable to regular session employees of the Senate and House of Representatives employed for the work of the legislative session of one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one *and for each regular legislative session thereafter*, for work done on and after the sixteenth day of June [, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-one].

Payment of compensation to regular session employees for work done after June 16.
