AN ACT

To amend section 516.1 of the act, approved the tenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," by extending the area in which school directors may attend certain meetings.

"Public School Code of 1949."

Section 516.1, act of March 10, 1949, P. L. 30, as added by act of January 18, 1952, P. L. 2152, amended.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 516.1 of the act, approved the tenth day of March, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine (Pamphlet Laws 30), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," as added by the act, approved the eighteenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred fifty-two (Pamphlet Laws 2152), is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 516.1. *Expenses for Attendance at Meetings of Educational or Financial Advantage to District [Expenses].*—When, in the opinion of the board of school directors, attendance of one or more of its members on any meeting held within the Commonwealth or *within three hundred (300) miles of the boundary thereof* (other than annual State and county conventions of school directors and meetings called by the county superintendent) will be of educational or financial advantage to the district, it may authorize the attendance of one or more of its members at such meeting, not exceeding two meetings in any one school year. Each person so authorized to attend and attending shall be reimbursed for all expenses actually and necessarily incurred in going to, attending and returning from the place of such meeting, but not exceeding eight dollars (\$8) per day, together with mileage at the rate of six cents (\$.06) for each mile in going to and returning from each meeting. Such expenses shall be paid by the treasurer of the school district in the usual manner out of the funds of the district, upon presentation of an itemized verified statement of such expenses.
