(b) The county commissioners, *in counties having a population of less than twelve thousand (12,000)*, one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1500) each, *and in counties having a population of twelve thousand (12,000) and more, two thousand dollars (\$2000) each.*

(c) The district attorney, in counties having a population of less than twelve thousand (12,000), one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200); and in counties having a population of twelve thousand (12,000) and more, but less than twenty thousand (20,000), one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800).

(d) The county auditors shall each receive ten dollars (\$10) for each day necessarily employed in the discharge of their duties.

(e) The jury commissioners shall each receive seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) for each day necessarily employed in the discharge of their duties. The said compensation shall be paid from the county treasury in the same manner as the salary or compensation of other county officers and employes.

Section 2. The provisions of this amending act shall become effective immediately upon final enactment; and shall be applicable to all pertinent county officers who shall be elected or appointed after the effective date of this act.

AN ACT

To further amend the act, approved the twenty-second day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," by changing or deleting certain routes and adding certain new routes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

State highways.

Certain routes, established by act of June 22, 1931, P. L. 594, and its amendments, deleted, as indicated, or amended.

Section 1. The following routes, established by the act, approved the twenty-second day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," and its amendments, are hereby deleted as indicated or amended to read as follows:

AN ACT

To further amend section two of the act, approved the twenty-second day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws 720), entitled "An act providing for the taking over by the Commonwealth, under certain terms, conditions and limitations, of certain streets in cities of the second class, second class A, and third class as State highways, and for the improvement, construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and maintenance by the Commonwealth of certain defined widths of said streets; imposing duties on such cities and on public utility companies using such streets; providing that no assessment shall be made upon the Commonwealth in the elimination of any grade crossing thereon; authorizing cities, persons, associations, or corporations to enter into agreements with the Commonwealth to bear a portion of the cost of construction or maintenance; providing for the assessment of certain portions of the cost of street improvements on abutting property owners; regulating the replacement of certain facilities of public utility companies; prohibiting the opening of said streets after improvement without a permit, and providing penalty therefor; regulating the maintenance of detours; authorizing the increase of city indebtedness in certain cases; and appropriating money in the Motor License Fund for the purposes of this act," by deleting certain routes.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1.
