Description.

Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of the eastern side of Harrington Road and the northern side of Grow Avenue; thence north 3 degrees 30 minutes east along Harrington Road a distance of four hundred three and sixty-nine one-hundredths (403.69) feet to an iron pin; thence north 75 degrees 30 minutes east a distance of eighty-six and four-tenths (86.40) feet to an iron pin; thence north 75 degrees 30 minutes east a distance of one hundred (100.00) feet to an iron pin; thence south 26 degrees 25 minutes east a distance of one hundred ninety-eight and five one-hundredths (198.05) feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Grow Avenue; thence south 43 degrees west a distance of ninety-two (92) feet to an iron pin; thence south 43 degrees west a distance of twenty and ninety-six one-hundredths (20.96) feet to a point; thence south 48 degrees 45 minutes west a distance of two hundred eighty-seven and six-tenths (287.60) feet to the place of beginning; containing 1.73 acres, more or less. Being originally 2 parcels of land title to which became vested in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by deed, dated July 11, 1929, and recorded in Deed Book No. 161 at Page 71, and by deed, dated October 13, 1930, and recorded in Deed Book 162 at Page 503.

Approval and execution of deeds of conveyance.

Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Disposition of proceeds.

Section 3. All moneys received from the sale of the land shall be deposited in the Motor License Fund.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, to sell and convey one acre, more or less, of land situate in Greene Township, Franklin County.

Real property.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Department of Property and Supplies, with approval of Governor, authorized to sell certain lands in Franklin County.

Section 1. The Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to sell at public sale to the highest bidder the following described two tracts of land situate in the Township of

Greene, County of Franklin and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

Parcel No. 1.—Beginning at an iron pin in the easterly side of Horst Avenue about one hundred twenty-five (125) feet from the centre of State Highway Route No. 35; thence north fifty-seven degrees twenty-two minutes west a distance of one hundred sixteen and sixty-seven one-hundredths (116.67) feet to a point in said Route No. 35; thence north twenty-nine degrees thirty minutes east a distance of one hundred fifty-eight and sixty-nine one-hundredths (158.69) feet along said Route No. 35 to a point on the westerly side of township road No. 517; thence south eighty-four degrees east a distance of one hundred twenty-seven and five one-hundredths (127.05) feet to an iron pin; thence south twenty-nine degrees thirty minutes west a distance of two hundred sixteen and fifteen one-hundredths (216.15) feet to the point of beginning; containing one-half acre, title to which became vested in the Commonwealth by deed, dated September 30, 1915, and recorded in the office for recording of deeds in Franklin County in Deed Book Volume 178 on page 428.

Parcel No. 2.—Beginning at an iron pin at the southerly side of State Highway Route No. 35 and the westerly side of Horst Avenue; thence south fifty-seven degrees twenty-two minutes east a distance of two hundred seventeen and sixty-five one-hundredths (217.65) feet along Horst Avenue to an iron pin; thence south thirty-two degrees thirty-eight minutes west a distance of seventy-three (73) feet to an iron pin; thence fifty-seven degrees twenty-two minutes west a distance of two hundred seventeen and sixty-five one-hundredths (217.65) feet to an iron pin at the southerly side of Route No. 35; thence north thirty-two degrees thirty-eight minutes east a distance of seventy-three (73) feet east along said Route No. 35 to the place of beginning; containing 0.3647 of an acre, more or less, title to which became vested in the Commonwealth by deed, dated April 18, 1929, and recorded in the office for recording of deeds in Franklin County in Deed Book Volume 234 on page 328.

Section 2. The deeds of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice and shall be executed by the Secretary of Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Approval and execution of deeds of conveyance.

Section 3. All moneys received from the sale of the land shall be deposited in the Motor License Fund.

Disposition of proceeds.

Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
