Section 2. The deed of conveyance shall be approved by the Department of Justice, and shall be executed by the Secretary of Property and Supplies in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

AN ACT

Relating to reciprocal agreements for the interstate transportation and support of the mentally ill.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Reciprocal Agreements.—The Department of Welfare, subject to the approval of the Attorney General, is hereby authorized to enter into reciprocal agreements with corresponding state agencies of other states regarding the interstate transportation or transfer of persons with mental illness or defect and to arrange with the proper officials in this State for the acceptance, transfer, and support of persons who are residents of this State but who are temporarily detained or who are receiving psychiatric or mental care in public institutions of other states in accordance with the terms of such agreements.

Department of Welfare authorized to enter reciprocal agreements, with approval of Attorney General, for interstate transportation and support of mentally ill.

Section 2. Uniformity of Interpretation.—This act shall be so interpreted and construed as to effectuate its general purpose to make uniform the laws of those states which enact it.

Uniformity.

Section 3. Effective Date.—This act shall take effect immediately.
