AN ACT

Requiring all tunnels on the Pennsylvania Turnpike to be painted white or lined with a light colored material and be equipped with continuous lighting.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Interior of
tunnels to be
lighted.

Section 1. The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission shall cause the interior of each tunnel on the Pennsylvania Turnpike to be painted white or be lined with a light colored material which reflects light. It shall also equip each tunnel with continuous lighting of sufficient candlepower to eliminate any blind-vision areas while traveling through the tunnels.

Act effective
immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

AN ACT

Requiring the erection and maintenance of medial barriers or guards on the Pennsylvania Turnpike between the Donegal and Bedford interchanges.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Medial guards
to be erected on
Pennsylvania
Turnpike be-
tween Donegal
and Bedford
interchanges.

Section 1. The Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission shall erect, and thereafter maintain and repair, along the Pennsylvania Turnpike between the Donegal and Bedford interchanges, medial guards or barriers which shall be of sufficient strength and height to effectively prevent vehicular traffic moving in one direction on the turnpike from crossing the medial line and entering the lanes provided for vehicular traffic moving in the opposite direction.

Act effective
immediately.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
