Section 2. This act shall take effect in ten days.

AN ACT

Authorizing the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission to acquire land on which is located the Old Bradford House in the City of Washington, Washington County; providing for its repair; authorizing an agreement for the administration thereof by the Washington County Historical Society, and making an appropriation.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Real property.

Section 1. The Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, with the approval of the Governor, is authorized to purchase, in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, a tract of land in the City of Washington, Washington County, on which is erected the Old Bradford House, from Charles W. McWreath, present owner.

The Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, with approval of Governor, authorized to purchase certain land in Washington County.

Section 2. The Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission is directed to repair or contract for the repair of the Old Bradford House to its original state.

Authority to repair, or contract for repair.

Section 3. When the Old Bradford House is repaired, the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, with the approval of the Governor, is authorized to enter into agreement with the Washington County Historical Society whereby it shall have possession and administration of the property including the grounds, in consideration of the covenant of that society to preserve and maintain the Old Bradford House in a good state of repair and to maintain it as an historic monument open to visitation by the public.

After repair, agreement authorized concerning possession and administration.

Section 4. The land shall not be acquired until its title has been approved by the Department of Justice.

Approval of title.

Section 5. The sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission for the payment of the purchase price and incidental expenses, including the completion of an abstract of title, and for the repairing of the Old Bradford House.

Appropriation.
