AN ACT

Amending the act of May 23, 1956 (P. L. 1662), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies to acquire, by gift, ninety-three acres, more or less, of land with buildings thereon in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, for maintenance by the Department of Health as a sanatorium or hospital for the reception and treatment of indigent persons affected with tuberculosis, and making an appropriation," extending its provisions to all persons suffering or suspected of suffering from tuberculosis.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Real property.

Section 1. The title and first paragraph of section 1, act of May 23, 1956 (P. L. 1662), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies to acquire, by gift, ninety-three acres, more or less, of land with buildings thereon in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, for maintenance by the Department of Health as a sanatorium or hospital for the reception and treatment of indigent persons affected with tuberculosis; and making an appropriation," are amended to read:

An Act

Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies to acquire, by gift, ninety-three acres, more or less, of land with buildings thereon in the City of Pittsburgh, Allegheny County, for maintenance by the Department of Health as a *sanatorium or hospital for the reception and treatment of [indigent] persons affected or suspected of being affected with tuberculosis; and making an appropriation.

New title.

Section 1. The Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, is hereby authorized to acquire, by gift, in the name of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for maintenance by the Department of Health as a sanatorium or hospital for the reception and treatment of [indigent] persons affected or suspected of being affected with tuberculosis, a tract of land with buildings thereon in the City of Pittsburgh, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

Department of Property and Supplies, with approval of Governor, authorized to acquire, by gift, certain lands with buildings thereon, located in Pittsburgh, Allegheny County.
